Entry level - Certificate II can be completed as a traineeship, through a Registered Training Organisation (RTO) or TAFE College. Training can be delivered through a workplace only program or in conjunction with a training organisation where the trainee is released to attend training days

LANDSCAPE APPRENTICE

Apprenticeship / trade level - Landscape apprenticeship training uses workplace training in conjunction with a Registered Training Organisation (RTO) or TAFE College to deliver a Certificate III in Landscape Construction as a 3 year apprenticeship using the workplace and a learning environment to complete the training

TRADESPERSON - Leads to QBCC Licence (Queensland Building & Construction Commission
